# MANAGEMENT

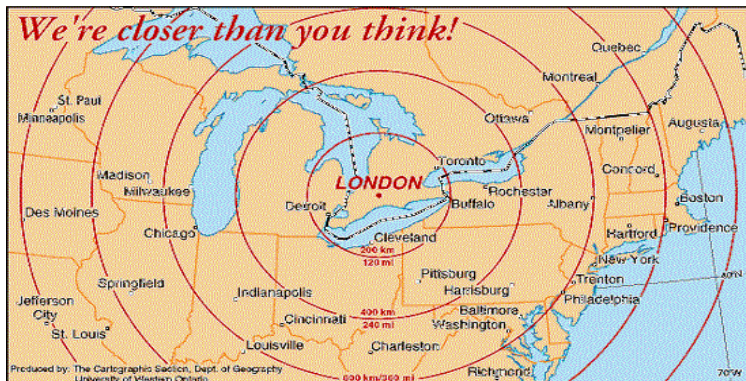

# TENANT TEAMS

## OUR HOCKEY TEAM

The London Knights Hockey Club has a rich tradition in producing top caliber hockey players since the team's inception 50 years ago. This has become especially evident over the past 20 seasons while the London Knights and their owners, Dale and Mark Hunter, have called Canada Life Place their home.

While at Canada Life Place, the Knights have consistently remained at the top of league standings, winning division and league titles while continually showcasing hockey's future stars. This has undoubtedly made the team a main attraction at the venue; establishing a strong base of season ticket holders and selling out nearly every game.

The most notable highlight of the Knights' 50 year history, was partnering with Canada Life Place to host the 2005 and 2014 MasterCard Memorial Cup – the epitome of major junior hockey supremacy. Both tournaments were a huge success for the City of London due in part to exceptional event planning, spectacular competition, tremendous city wide support and involvement from leagues, fans and volunteers. The Knights capped off the 2005 Memorial Cup by winning the tournament in front of thousands of hometown fans. Canada Life Place has also been host to the Knights winning back to back Ontario Hockey League Championships in 2012 and 2013.



## OUR BASKETBALL TEAM

The London Lightning is a Canadian professional basketball team based in London, Ontario, Canada. The team was a charter member of the Basketball Super League which began play with the 2011-12 season

In their inaugural season, the Lightning won the 2012 NBL Championship and continued to win the league championship again in the following 2013 season. In their second season the Lightning broke the league attendance record, peaking at 8,725 fans. Though the team saw tremendous success in the stand and the community, the Lightning were eliminated in the first playoff round.

The Lightning franchise along with the Basketball Super League are putting basketball on the Canadian map and are gaining recognition from around the world as a premier team in a premier league that demonstrates high level basketball. The Basketball Super League features teams in London, Kitchener/Waterloo, Montreal, St. John's, Pontiac, Sudbury, and Windsor.

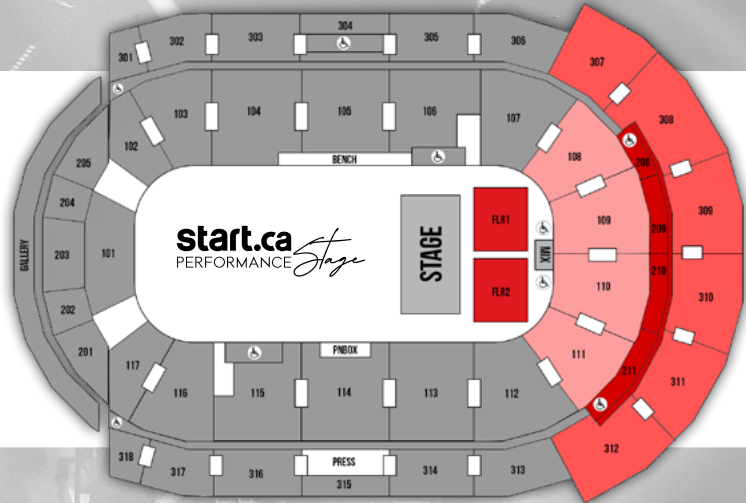

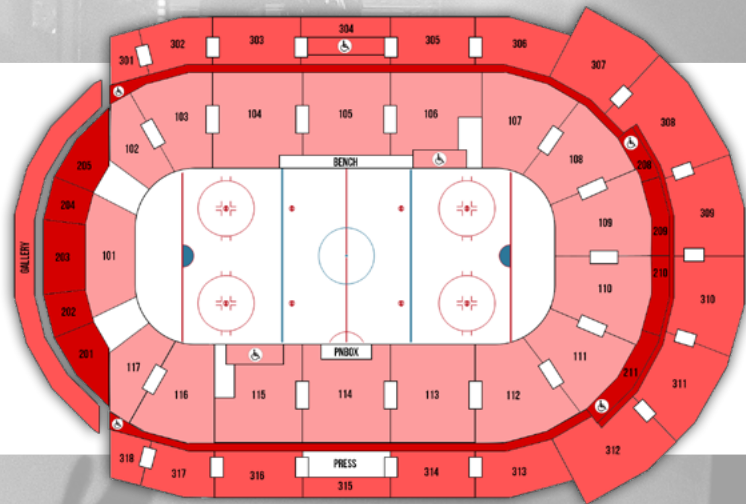

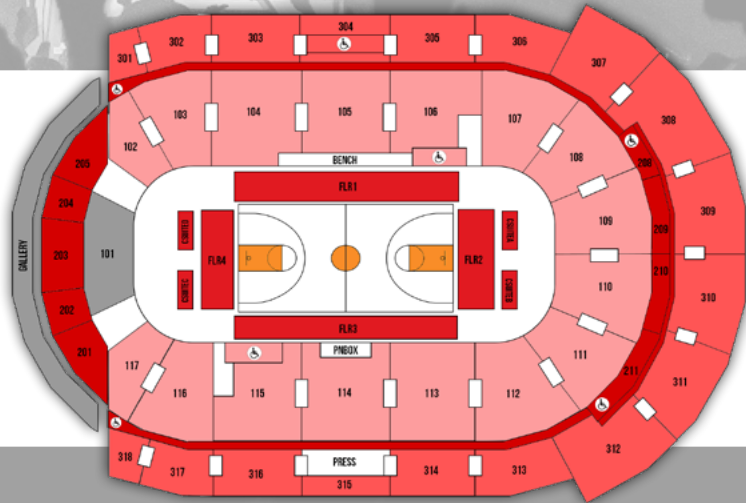

## Box Office Rates and Regulations

Canada Life Place uses the Ticketmaster as our ticketing provider. Ticketmaster's success is rooted in strong partnerships, constant innovation and industry leadership. They work with clients worldwide, to connect them with their fans, helping to make more live memories, everyday.

The use of the Canada Life Place Box Office is required, unless noted otherwise in contract, to be used for all ticketed events in order to provide accurate control of receipts and maximum service to guests.

Canada Life Place will hold up to 2% of manifested tickets for its own use. This may include purchased tickets and complimentary tickets up to the contractual maximum. Seats may also be held for the purposes of relocating patrons.

Canada Life Place shall order, audit and determine sales outlets for all tickets sold for the venue's events. Management shall have complete custody and control of all monies received from the sale of tickets for the purpose of applying same toward payment of any balance for rent or otherwise due to the Arena. All money received from ticket sales shall be deemed held in trust by Canada Life Place as a bailment for the benefit of ticket purchasers. At no time will tickets be placed on sale unless a contract is signed and record of deposit is on file.

In this mode the front of stage is moved forward approx. one section. This mode can start at 4,282 easily, and expand twice - once to fill the lower bowl and level 200, and then again by opening level 300.

The Start.ca Performance Stage has a capacity of 3,933 with reserved seating on the floor. Depending on sightlines, seats can be killed upstairs in favour of opening more seats downstairs to keep the 3,933 capacity. We can go above the capacity if you need to. Total capacity depends on sightlines.

**Note - These are sellable capacities (ex. they do not include the standard tech holds, kills, or holds for relocates). These are guidelines only - assumptions have been made that may not match your show's requirements. Please contact one of the Event Managers for show-specific questions.**

# RENTAL RATES AND CONDITIONS

## Deposit Requirements and Procedures

A deposit is required as consideration in order to secure a date at Canada Life Place. This amount is due upon execution of the contract or whenever another potential user challenges at date. In case of multiple events, Canada Life Place will hold the deposit as a floating deposit unless those dates are challenged, in which case the promoter must provide the additional deposit for each challenged date. Management reserves the right to require an additional sum in advance as a damage deposit, which is refundable after the event is settled and when a facility check is completed. Management further reserves the right to require a deposit to cover all estimated expenses, such as rent, ticketing fees, set up, staffing, damages, advertising, electrical services and equipment.

## Settlement

Canada Life Place will produce a Box Office statement and settlement of all monies owed upon closing the Box Office for the final performance.

## Insurance

Each tenant must provide public liability insurance with a minimum combined single limit of two or five million dollars naming Canada Life Place, its trustees, officers, employees, agents, Global Spectrum Limited Partnership, London Civic Centre Limited Partnership, the Arena Trust and the City of London. A certificate of insurance from an acceptable company must be received no later than 10 days prior to the event date. Canada Life Place can provide this insurance at an additional cost.

## Event Requirements and Staffing

Canada Life Place will provide, and the lessee will be charged, for all event-related staffing. Canada Life Place requires general event staff and security for the building and perimeter. Additional security may be added to the event if in management's opinion the safety of the public is at risk. All event requirements must be coordinated with and approved by Management.

## Food and Beverage

All food, beverage and concessions are operated and controlled by OVG Hospitality. Together with Canada Life Place, OVG Hospitality will determine the number of concessions and stands opened to properly serve the public.

All arrangements for serving food and beverages, and the sale of concessions should be made through the OVG Hospitality Coordinator at [catering@canadalifepace.com](mailto:catering@canadalifepace.com).

## Marketing Services

The Canada Life Place "In-House" agency can assist with the numerous details involved to successfully market your event. We can provide the production and placement of print and electronic advertising at the standard rate of 15% on gross advertising costs. For a negotiated fee (based on time, labour and expenses) Canada Life Place can also assist with promotions, public relations and publicity needed to ensure ticket sales through the venue's Advertising Program. Also offered are full service graphic design and alteration services, a promotional street team and can execute effective social media and viral marketing campaigns.

## Group Sales

Our Group Sales Department would be happy to implement a group sales program for your event, at a commission rate of 10% of the overall group dollars (plus reimbursement of direct expenses).

## Merchandise/Novelties

The venue sells merchandise and will negotiate terms with each promoter. Net sales shall be gross receipts minus credit card fees. Our standard rate is 75/25.

## Arena Logo

The Canada Life Place logo must be used in all materials used to promote events. The logo must be displayed at the bottom of newspaper ads, brochures, billboards, etc. Approval must be received from our Marketing Department prior to use.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## Alcohol

No alcoholic beverages may be brought into Canada Life Place, alcoholic beverages are only to be sold by OVG Hospitality, and no alcoholic beverages can be consumed in the parking lot as governed by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.

## Cameras and Recording Devices

As a general rule, cameras and recording devices of any kind are not permitted inside the building. This is subject to change on an event-by-event basis. If by chance, a guest brings a camera or recording device to an event the guest will be asked to return the item to his or her vehicle. Canada Life Place cannot hold any personal property belonging to a guest.

## Balloons, Tape and Tacks

Helium balloons are not permitted in the building. Only 'Painters' tape may be used to post signs, the cost of removing excessive tape or tape residue will be the responsibility of the tenant. Stickers and adhesive backed decals are not to be given out in or around the building. Nails and screws are not to be driven into the Venue floor or walls.

## Guest Conduct

Canada Life Place strives to provide its guests with a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable atmosphere. In order to achieve this, the following guidelines apply:

- Guests interfering with other guests' ability to enjoy the event may be subject to ejection from the building
- Guests using foul or abusive language, inappropriate or unacceptable gestures may be ejected from the building
- Guests appearing to be intoxicated may be ejected from Canada Life Place and turned over to the authorities

## Guidelines for Exhibiting Motorized Vehicles

- There shall be no refueling of vehicles inside the building
- There shall be an adequate amount of fire extinguishers in and around the area where the vehicle is being displayed
- The keys for vehicles that are in the building must at all times be readily available to Canada Life Place
- Management and stored in the Building Control Room located at Gate #3.  
Keys for unattended vehicles or vehicles remaining over night must be given to the Canada Life Place Management
- Vehicles with any type of leak cannot be displayed, parked in the building or on the property adjacent to the building
- The maximum amount of fuel contained shall be the lessor of a 1/4 tank or 5 gallons per vehicle
- Batteries must be disconnected at all times while in the building except for move-in and move-out
- There shall not be any storage of flammable fuel in the building except for that which is in the vehicle
- There shall be no repair work done on vehicles while inside the building
- Fuel tanks doors must be locked or fuel caps taped shut
- Vehicles may not be started except for move-in and move-out
- Cleaning of vehicles is the responsibility of the vehicle owner and must follow building policies

## Leaflets/Brochures

Distribution of any printed material or selling of any items is prohibited on Canada Life Place grounds, including the parking lots, walkways, and inside the building unless permission from Canada Life Place is granted.

## Re-Entry into the Venue

Once a guest leaves the venue during an event, there is no re-entry permitted.

## Re-selling of Tickets

Re-selling of tickets by private parties is prohibited on Canada Life Place property.

## **Selling of illegal Merchandise (Bootlegging)**

Selling of illegal merchandise (merchandise not having approval of Canada Life Place Management) is prohibited on Canada Life Place property as well as by law.

## **Smoking**

As per City of London By-Law smoking is not permitted inside Canada Life Place. Anyone smoking in the building can be fined and may be asked to leave the facility.

## **Sponsorship**

Canada Life Place own signage rights inside and outside the Venue. Advertising signs or banners that tenants wish to display must be pre-approved by Canada Life Place Management.

## **Metal Detectors**

For the safety and security of our fans, entertainers, players and staff, Canada Life Place employs the use of Garrett PD 6500i walkthrough metal detectors for all events taking place at the venue. Qualified designated security personnel will be onsite to facilitate the screening as well as any secondary searches that may be required. Patrons who require alternative screening options due to medical or accessible reasons may request this upon arrival at the venue. Fans that refuse to submit to either a walkthrough, wand or pat-down search shall be refused entry.

## **Items Not Permitted in Canada Life Place**

- Aerosol cans
- Air horns
- Outside Alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs
- Animals (except certified service dogs for the disabled)
- Beach balls and other inflatable
- Bota bags or wine skins
- Bullhorns or noise makers
- Cameras or recording devices (varies by event)
- Selfie Sticks
- Fireworks, firearms or other weapons
- Framed backpacks
- Glass bottles or aluminum cans
- Ice chests (coolers) or thermos containers
- Gang colours
- Laser pointers
- Outside food or beverages
- Skateboards or rollerblades
- Sticks or clubs (including signs attached to sticks)
- Stools or folding chairs
- Opaque Water bottles or mugs

## LOAD IN

Show load-in is located at the southwest end of the Canada Life Place, approximately 75' from the arena floor.

There are two loading docks with load levelers and dock seals and one drive-in door that provides access to the arena floor. There is adequate parking for fifteen buses or trucks outside the load-in area.

Additional secure lots located a short distance from the building are available if needed for storage of extra trailers.

### Forklift

Canada Life Place has two forklifts with lift capacities of 3500 lbs. and 5000 lbs. Both of the lifts have a lift height of 17' and fork length of 4' and each are propane fueled.

## PRODUCTION SERVICES

Canada Life Place has many amenities to make your stay as comfortable as possible.

## PRODUCTION OFFICE

The production office is centrally located near the loading dock, locker rooms and stage floor. The office is outfitted with chairs, tables and phones. High speed internet jacks as well as a strong back of house password protected wireless system makes accessing the internet a breeze.

## Dressing Rooms

There are 4 primary dressing rooms located behind the stage which are secure from public access. Each room has restroom and shower facilities, wireless internet service and can be outfitted with phones and furniture. Additional rooms are also available. Refer to the Back Of House map for more information.



## Telephones

Telephones are installed in a variety of locations throughout Canada Life Place.

## Locks and Keys

Dressing rooms can be secured with locks and keys. Keys are available through the Event Manager and key holders are responsible for the return of the keys.

## Runners

Canada Life Place can provide runners upon request. Our runners come with a standard 4-door passenger car and cell. Other needs (vans, SUV's, etc) are available. Please advance your requirements with the Event Manager.

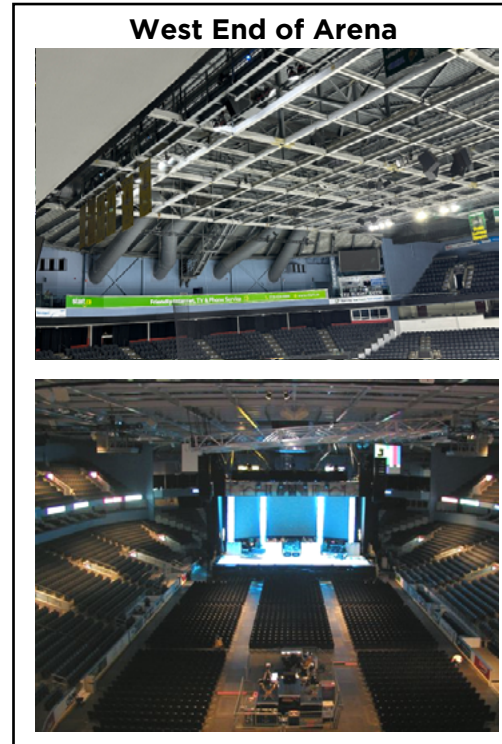
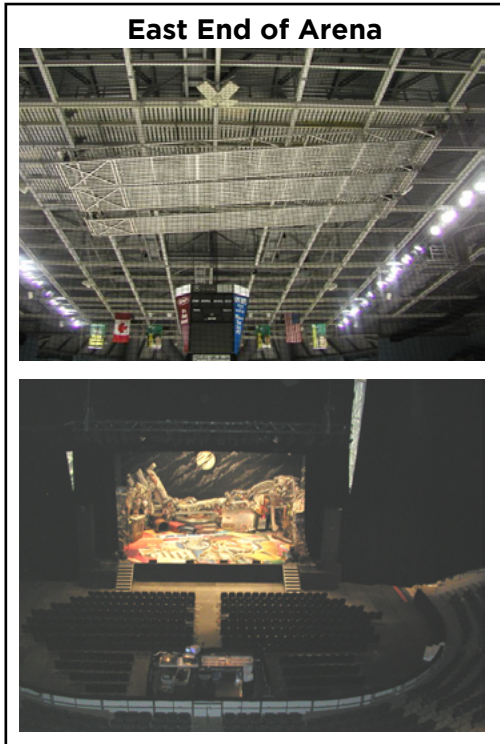
OVG Hospitality Services, the in-house catering provider, can create exceptional full course meals specially prepared to meet your needs, neatly dressed tables and a friendly staff.

## PUTTING UP THE SHOW

### Rigging

Distance from floor to the low/rigging steel is 58'. Distance from arena floor to the roof is 70'. All the structural steel is divided into 11'- 7" x 11'- 7" quadrants. (12' x 12' centres).

Total rigging weight for an end or centre stage configuration is 95,000 lbs. Rigging weight for Small Concert is 65,000 lbs. All rigging plans, including the weight of each point, must be submitted to and approved by Spectra Venue Management prior to load in. Loads exceeding the above limits are subject to engineering approval.



### Show Power

Canada Life Place has 2 x 3 phase, 4 wire services at 625A per phase, and 1 x 3 phase, 4 wire service at 416A per phase located in show power. An additional 416A 3P service and 208A 3P service is available if required.

## TELEVISION/BROADCASTING

Canada Life Place is fully equipped for television broadcasting courtesy of Rogers Television. Contact the Event Manager for permission to use Rogers resources. Canada Life Place is a “plug and play” venue with all necessary amenities required for local, national or international television and radio broadcasts

## Press Deck

We have a fully functional press gallery which can accommodate up to 20 persons. The press deck is complete with data and phone lines as well as 2 turret camera positions. Canada Life Place has hosted most major networks including CBC, TSN and Sportsnet.

## Bowl Reduction Curtains

Canada Life Place has the ability to curtain off the 300 level to enhance the look of shows that do not require the upper level.



## AUDIO AND VIDEO

Canada Life Place is fully capable to assist with all of your audio and visual needs. All house lighting and sound controls are overseen by the Sound Control room located in the SW corner of 200 level.

We have 6 in-house ClearCom headset communication systems with 15 stations including the sound control room, house lights, camera positions and spotlight platforms. The building is also equipped with a hearing assist device for the hearing impaired.

## Sound System

Comprised of JBL AM5412 series speakers and JBL ASB4128 series subs, all suspended from the arena low steel. Our house sound system provides a full range of high-powered sound to all seating areas, concourse levels and bathrooms in the facility.

The ability to run a back of house/dressing room paging system is available upon request.

## Lighting

House and Sport lighting are controlled from our Sound Room on L200. House lighting is fully dimmable to control the atmosphere. Sport lights consist of 78 Ephesus 550 white LED fixtures, and 8 Ephesus prism 750 RGBA fixtures – which produce an average 171.8 horizontal foot-candles.

## Spotlights

We have six 2K Xenon ‘Super Trouper’ Spotlights located on spot platforms easily accessible from the full-service catwalk.

## Scoreboard and 360 Power Ring

The new center-hung display boasts significant improvements in size and resolution! At the goal ends, it measures 20 feet across, which is 50% larger than the previous 13 feet 6 inches display. On the bench and penalty side, it is even more impressive, with a size 75% larger at 24 feet compared to the old 13 feet 6 inches.

The 360 Power Ring is digital signage that surrounds the bowl and measures 170 feet around and is approximately 2 feet high. Installed by Daktronics, it provides many features and capabilities including animation, advertising and live score updates.

Use of the video screens and power ring are available for a fee. For more information, contact the Event Manager.

# ARBOUR SYSTEM

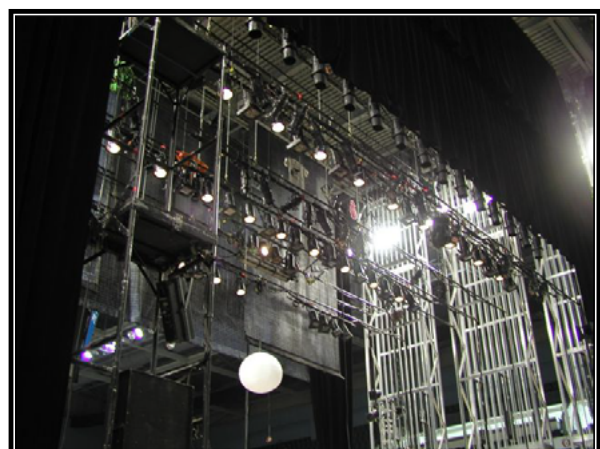
## ARBOUR SYSTEM

- Single purchase system containing 30 line sets.
- 3 groups of 10 lines each at 8' ½" centers.
- Distance from first group to the second is 4' and distance from second to third is 4'8".
- All pipes are hung according to the shows line set list prior to load-in.
- Pipes are 60' long. Maximum weight per line is 1000lbs
- Pipes are loaded one at a time and a capsten winch is used to pull the lines and load the counter weights from the ground
- Average out trim based on a 4' stage is 46'7".



## PROSCENIUM, VALENCE, SIDE MASKINGS & STAGE

- We provide a 60' wide black backdrop on line 30.
- A proscenium opening of 48' wide is provided, however it can be narrowed if the legs that make up the backdrop are not needed. We do not provide a traveler.
- The valence can be adjusted for a trim height of 36'-46'.
- The maximum stage width using the arbour system is 60' wide.
- We do not have an apron DS from our proscenium. Separate decks for audio towers can be installed if required.
- If lagging is required, locations must be advanced with the Event Manager prior to arrival.

## FRONT OF HOUSE LIGHTING TRUSS

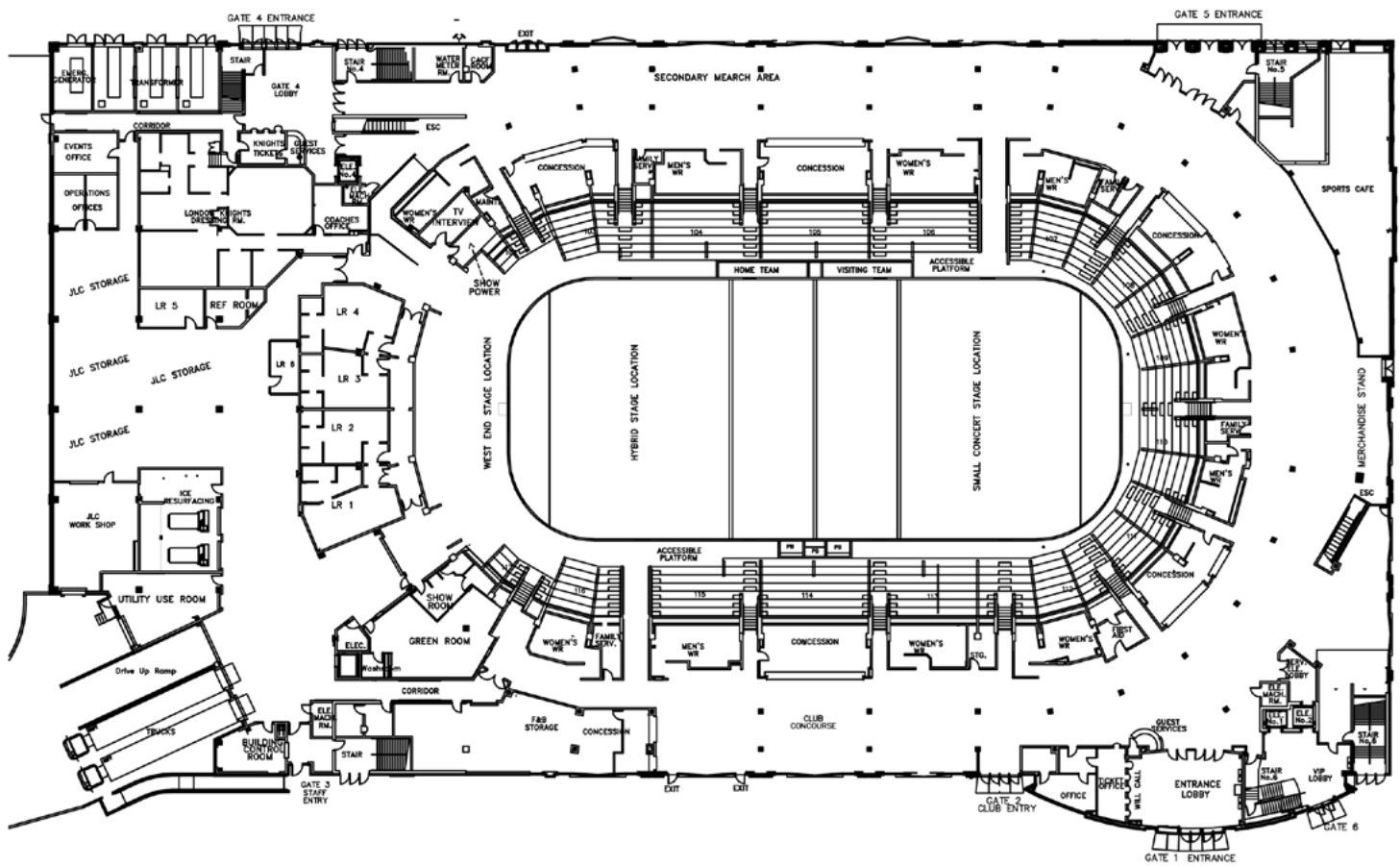
- Mounted on level 200.
- 64 linear feet of rail
- Easily accessible from pre-installed scaffolding.
- 250 feet of cable is required to reach closest upstage corner.
- The truss does not have any pre-installed lighting.



## POWER

- 2 X 400amp, 3 phase carts are rolled up to the USE from the Show Power Room.
- If more than 800amps are required, the show must provide the cable to run to the Show Power Room which is 175' from the USE in theatre set-up.

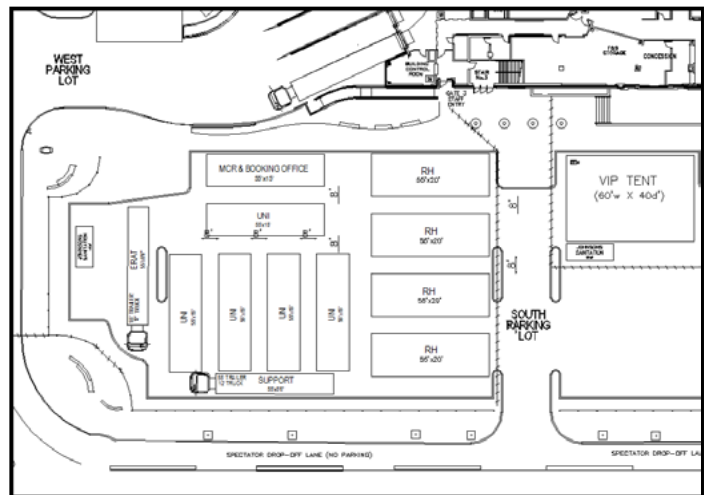
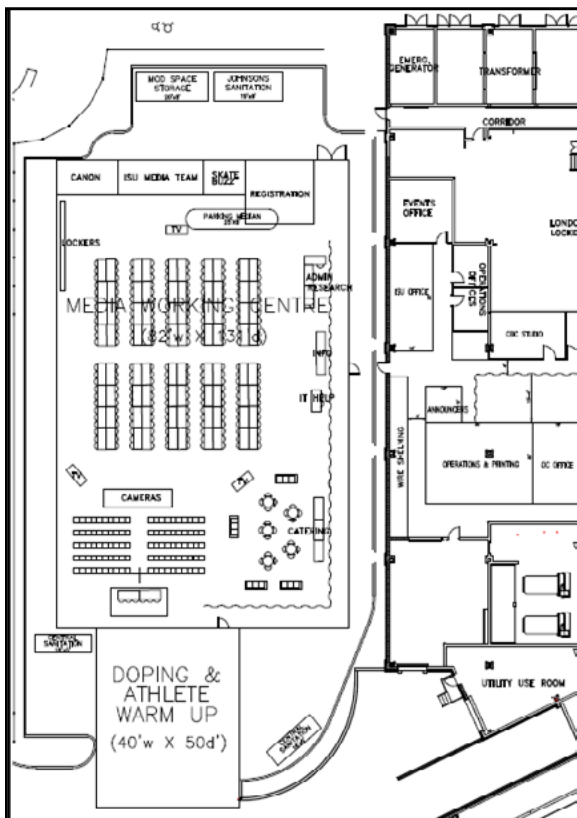
A variety of events have utilized our exterior areas for additional performer, media, storage, and office spaces.

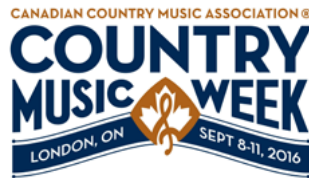
